

## Station Road

Dear Member

We thought you would appreciate an update on the operations on Station Road. The work has proceeded more slowly than planned, and access for the public so far has been easier than expected. However, the next couple of weeks will involve work on the whole road surface with heavy machinery.

The closures will be:

Week commencing Monday 20<sup>th</sup> 7.30 to 4pm

Week commencing Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> 8.30 to 4pm ( no work on Mon 27<sup>th</sup> - Bank Holiday)

The email below from North Somerset Council explains the operations in detail.

*Our Contractor has informed us that the carriageway resurfacing operation will start on Monday.*

*The first process is to remove 40-45mm off from the current roads surface. This sequence will start from Station Close through to the crossroads at West Town Road. It is hoped this will be completed in one day, perhaps run into Tuesday. On Tuesday, some of the civils works (dependant on the surfacing) i.e., kerbs and ironwork will be adjusted this will likely run into Wednesday. On Wednesday some further areas along Station road will be removed by a further depth of 60mm and reinstated with new material. On Thursday and Friday the road will be resurfaced. There is every chance this will run into the following week Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> August (as no works are due to take place on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> – Bank Holiday). It is hoped the speed cushions/raised tables and road markings will be then all completed by Friday 31<sup>st</sup> August.*

*The works will unfortunately continue into a further week with the closure operational now until Friday 31<sup>st</sup> August as originally advertised in the press. The assumption was that the contractor would finish sooner but they have come across some site difficulties.*

*The closure will operate much the same way as the previous two weeks, but there will be times where (physically) access will be restricted due to the plant machinery and the operation taking place. It is anticipated for next week only that the closure will start at 07:30 instead of 08:30 to assist with the material deliveries and wagons.*

*If you have any queries, the Traffic Marshals on-site will have the most up-to-date information on the exact whereabouts of the contractor each day and access.*

*I would be grateful if you could circulate with your customers.*

*I will endeavour to update you all again next week.*
